Did You Know?:

- 27 out of 38 St. Chris alumni (class of 2015') graduated from either Vandalia- Butler or Chaminade-Julienne in 2019. 17 of these 27 were National Honor Society members, 17 were awarded some form of a college scholarship, 15 out of the 15 alums that graduated from CJ began college this Fall.
- From the Vandalia-Butler graduation class of 2018, St. Chris alums stats included, 8 out of 11 National Honor Society and 9 out of 11 receiving some form of a college scholarship.
- For four consecutive years, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019 a St. Chris alum has been a Semi-finalist or Finalist for the National Merit Scholarship Program at their respective high school.
- 110 out of 179 St. Chris families (61%) are receiving some form of tuition assistance, such as The Monnin Grant, EdChoice Scholarship, EdChoice Expansion or the One Faith, One Hope, One Love grant from the Archdiocese. Note: The application window is now open for the 2020-21 school year for the One Faith, One Hope, One Love grant. A grant up to \$1200 can be issued.
