Dear Parents,

I am sure many of you had to put on the back burner vacation plans during our spring break week. My wife and I had plans to visit Charleston, SC for a five day get away. I guess that will be on our agenda for 2021. You can see why I state we have enormous responsibilities. The challenge is monumental, but in my short time working with the St. Chris faculty, I am certain they will do their best under difficult circumstances.
