Proud to state that our 8<sup>th</sup> graders had a Core Composite National Percentile Ranking of the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile in math and reading and a grade equivalent of 13.0.
- Our new principal, Mr. Tim O'Loughlin, has been working with me as we begin to make the transition to his leadership. He will be taking over the first week of June.
- Incoming kindergarten families, please note we will share our kindergarten screening plans in next week's Dear Parents. We hope to pinpoint the first week of June for the screening.
