Plan For Return Of Books, Equipment And Materials For Current Grade One To Seven Students.

If at all possible we would like families with a last name A-L to return books from 9:00 AM to Noon, and last name M- Z noon to 2:30 PM. Any school textbook, library book, calculator or chrome book needs to be returned on this day.

Drop-off areas:

Grades 1 & 2- return tables to be set up outside the connector.

Grades 3, 4 & 5- return tables to be set up outside the Emmaus Center entrance.

Grades 6 & 7- return tables to be set up by the flag pole or main entrance of the school.

ALSO, please pick up your Summer Solutions workbooks at this time. They will be available by the return tables. We do have a check list of who has picked them up.

Guidelines for Screening Day:

There will only be 6 students at a time in the screening area which will be held in the gym so there is plenty of space away from each other.

We still have a couple of families that have not signed up for the screening. Please contact the office at 937-898-5104 to schedule your appointment.

- Do not arrive early; come at your scheduled time.
- Walk your child to the front door.
- Staff will greet you and all staff will be wearing masks.
- Paperwork being returned can be placed in the drop off container at the front door.
- If you plan to stay, we highly recommend that you wear a mask while waiting in the cafeteria and following social distancing guidelines.
- Please do not worry about your child wearing a mask as we do not want that to be a distraction.
- If you have siblings or other family members with you, drop off your child and we will ask you to wait in your car. We will call you when your child is finished.
- All surfaces and materials will be cleaned and changed out between students.
- Expect about an hour for the screening process.

- Current 8th grade families- There are a couple of students who failed to turn in their materials on the assigned day.
